Brad Goans brought up that there are parcels in Charleston View coming up soon for auction, due to unpaid taxes, that the Board might like to consider. Minimum bids start at \$100, a \$535 deposit is required to bid, lots have no well or power. Billy has a map of the parcels up for auction.

Member Marks asked that the wind torn sign on the water tender be taken down and the water tender moved home.

Billy Eichenbaum commented that no one seems to have time to work on grant writing, and heard there may be a county grant writer and asked if the board would follow up on that.

Admin Dennett presented a letter from Death Valley Academy selling ad/thanks space in the 2013 year book and suggested a full page ad at \$100. Chair Flinchum said she would contribute. Member Marks moved to fund a full page ad at \$100 for the DVA school year book, Member Regnell 2nded, no further discussion, vote taken and passed 5,0,0.

Admin Dennett reminded us that in order to be able to borrow from our future tax revenue, we'll need to approve a resolution. A sample to borrow \$20,000 was presented and suggested it be on the agenda for the next regular meeting.

The treasury and transaction reports were reviewed and there was some discussion. Member Regnell moved to moved to move \$4,869 from account 5001 to 5012 to cover FASIS (workers comp) bill coming up, Member Marks 2nded. There was further discussion, vote taken and motion passed 5,0,0.

Member Regnell moves to accept the transaction report, Member Marks 2nded, no further discussion, vote taken and passed 5,0,0.

B. Fire Chief's Report

Chief Levy gave an update on radios needing repair, there are 4 needing repair, 2 handheld, 1 mobile and 1 handheld under warranty total estimate for repair \$355. Member Regnell moved to approve the expense to repair the radios. Member Sanborn 2nded, no further discussion, vote taken and passed 5,0,0.

It was a slow month for calls, 2 medical, 1 motor vehicle, 1 propane leak at Shoshone motel. The entire crew spent 12 hours at the Landing Zone in the Baker to Vegas relay, there was a low volume of calls there too, due to cooler weather than last year. The Dennetts brought their RV and there was a lot of good food for crew and invited guests. It was a good exercise and good practice with the tender.

Volunteer Sinohui passed Hazmat Operation

Working on a CAL Fire grant for Personal Protective Equipment and 1" hose, to be completed

this weekend. Chief Levy also made visits to St. Theresa's for inspections of sprinkler and fire alarm systems. We should consider adopting a schedule for inspection fees.

C. Chief Administrator's Report

Admin Dennett reported that Maddy Grants coming up in 1 1/2 months and he will work with Chief Levy on that.

Chief Levy reported that Marlys Skarry and her group are making feedbag bags for us to sell as a novelty. We'll work on bringing Flameology out for the fall fundraiser. Chair Flinchum still has to follow up on how legal issues of auxiliary relationship to the District.

a. Bright Source Update

Chief Levy presented one more invoice from Ronnie Coleman and said he was going to order some more copies of the Declaration of Deployment documents. Member Marks noted that the command vehicle was not listed as part of the fleet and that should be corrected before more ordered. Chief Levy gave a summary of the Hidden Hills project application and Bright Source's request to suspend the application. He believes they are working on a redesign including molten salt for energy storage and they may reopen their application at some point in the future.

some discussion on things to consider, including security/video and test pit for testing fire engines.

A. Discuss and consider renewal of former Dunn and Bradstreet federal ID number.

Admin Dennett is having trouble renewing our Dunn and Bradstreet ID online. It's required if we apply for federal grants. Chief Levy will help look at this next week.

B. Discuss and consider going forward with plans for District EMT School

Admin Dennett described his plans for a District EMT School. And presented a request to approve funding to send him to EMT Instructor II class in June at a cost of \$710. Needs to be registered in the next two weeks. There was discussion and a revisit of the budget. Member Marks moved to move \$750 from lone 5265 to line _____ to cover Instructor II training, Member Sanborn 2nded. There was more discussion, vote taken and passed 4 aye, 1 nay, 0 abstain.

Member Sanborn asked for a summary in writing of when we've borrowed against our income revenue, when it's due and what Admin Dennett thinks we'll need to do going forward.

There's a lot to do, but it seem to be getting done. Chair Flinchum asked Staff if there was anything the board could help with. Not at this time.
