B. Fire Chief's Report

The Fire Chief gave his report, 5 calls for service, 3 Medical, and 2 Motor Vehicle. Vehicles in same condition as last month, diesel still in shop, 2 running ambulances, SCBA bottles back in service. SCBA Compressor may require a service call. Larry attended a free training on responding to incidents involving alternative fuel vehicles. Training was put on by NFPA, free material available for digital download. Member Noel suggested purchasing flash drives for downloads.

C. Chief Administrator's Report

Chief Admin gave his report, he polled the EMT's and Firefighters regarding call out pay and all were willing to go without or reduced call out pay. A discussion ensued and the general consensus was that we would only consider eliminating call out pay if the District is in a dire emergency and as of the most recent reading of the budget reports, we are not there.

#5640 is the new budget line item for new fire station, it is now in #5265 but needs to be moved. A discussion ensued regarding a temporary or permanent line item for new fire house.

Request from EMT's for an advanced EMT class. Would cost \$850 through ICEMA. We can teach it but not certify it. To be added to the agenda as a voting item for next meetings
