# REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS Wednesday, September 21, 2022

The Governing Board of the Southern Inyo Fire Protection District held a regular (teleconference) business meeting on Wednesday, September 21, 2022 at 6pm via Zoom.

# I. Call to order and determination of quorum

A. Re-adopt re-resolution. Horne moves to accept resolution. Zellhoefer seconds. Carries 3-0-0.

  - a. 4 calls last month. Making progress on the fire water tank.

  - a. FAIRA check returned but County resubmitted on 9/14.
  - b. Conditional Use Permit application in progress. Will need \$1500 application fee.
  - BLM update. Application for patent for 501 Furnace Creek property is submitted and being processed. Will take 12-18 months according to BLM.
  - d. Elections update. Flinchum and Lee only ones to respond to request for letter of intent to the County so we will have 3 members. Jerry: Put up board vacancy notice. Send to Rose too.

    - a.i. New tires and repair done on fast attack.

  - a. Water Kiosk
    - a.i. Our County grants (annual for water kiosk and fundraiser grant) passed preliminary budget phase. Will be voted on next week.
    - a.ii. State Water Board grant/project
      - a.ii.1. Water Kiosk Committee decided to decline the state funding if our County grant comes through. Will resubmit for generator and wiring only.
  - b. Fundraising
    - b.i. County fundraiser grant probably going through so we will move Fling to spring. Flinchum will start fundraiser committee.

- B. Fire water tower/firehouse update
  - a. Macbrohn painted the tank.
  - b. Macbrohn: Some mold in the walls of office building. Getting building ready for work on it. We will schedule a new work party. Levy: Need siding on the inside of parapet wall roof. Roof work could be done for less than \$1000 in materials. Horne moves to spend up to \$1000. Lee seconds. Carries 4-0-0.

  - a. Flinchum: Drafted a letter to Obernolte. Will be proofed and sent.

  - a. Zellhoefer moves to apply for the CUP and approve \$1500 application fee. Horne seconds. Carries 4-0-0. Levy: Supervisors can waive the fee. Flinchum will call Matt Kingsley about that. Levy: We need to specify on the conditional use permit that we are only applying for the 2.5 acre plot, not the entire 1000-acre plot.

  - a. Zellhoefer moves to accept hardship resolution. Horne seconds. Carries 4-0-0.
